of Trust bearing date the 1st day of May 1805 did sell
and convey unto Matthew Calvert and to his heirs &c one certain
Tract of Land Situate lying and being in the County of said
containing thirty Acres which said Tract was purchased of William
Woods for securing the payment of fifty pounds and Interest
thereon from the date of the said Dea justly and from the said
said William Bames to the said Matthew Calvert with
a right of promise and redemption on the payment of the aforesaid
Sum and Interest &c To the said Matthew Calvert his heirs
and assigns and return as the said William Bames hath
paid and satisfied unto the said Matthew Calvert the sum of
fifty pounds and Interest due thereon to the date hereof
Now Know ye that the said Matthew Calvert for and
in consideration aforesaid, have and by these presents do release
through the Minister's Claim & Demand from the the said Matthew Calvert
and former Suit Claim unto the said W^m Bames his heirs &c
and to the aforesaid Tract or parcel of Land, and do hereby
acquits and discharge the said William Bames his heirs &c
and a administrator or assigns from the said Debt and Demand
