one hundred forty eight and three quarters acres be the same more or
less, lying and being in the County of Hampton State of Virginia
on the West side of the James River, and bounded as followeth Begin-
ning at a large oak on the road a corner of Peyton Lundy's line, then
along the said Peyton Lundy's line N. 58° W. 50 poles to an Illinois oak
in a large patch, thence along said path, to a red corner of said
Peyton Lundy and Elizabeth Sullivan's line thence along said Sullivan's
line N. 58° W. 3 poles to a red oak thence S. 5° W. 64 poles to a black
oak thence S. 88° W. 66 poles to a black gum a corner of Elizabeth
Sullivan's and William Wright's line, thence S. 17° E. 60 poles to two oaks
in the road, thence S. 24° E. 84 poles to a Locust tree a corner thence
N. 10° West 46 poles, thence N. 37° E. 55 poles to a Gum, thence N. 61°
W. 53 poles to a small gum at the hand, thence up the various course
of the branch that the said dam is a crop to a small gum on the
road, thence along the said road to the Beginning, it being a

Branch &c.
