This Indenture made this 20th day of September in the year our Lord Christ 1805. Between John, Esq. Winbourne of the County Southampton and Parish of Netley of the one part and John Hough of the aforesaid County and Parish of the other part Witnesseth that the said John, Esq. Winbourne for and in consideration of the sum of twenty dollars lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said John Hough the receipt whereof the said John, Esq. Winbourne doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said John Hough has hereunto administrator and assigns by these presents hath granted bargained sold Enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alien enfeoff and confirmed unto the said John Hough and his heirs and assigns forever all ^{that} tract or parcel of Land Situate lying & being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Netley containing by Estimation one acre be the same more or less and bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at three oaks at the road in Mike Jeffers line thence along alone to a pine corner tree in the S^r Jeffers line and said Winbourne thence along alone to a black oak a corner tree in the said Winbourne and Thomas Johnson line to a black oak at the road thence up the said road to the first Station together with all houses out houses Bayling buildings yards gardens orchards trees ways water and watercourses profits here decimants and appurtenances to the said plantation track or parcel of Land belonging or in anywise appertaining
