Denson his heirs and assigns forever, and himself therewith fully and entirely satisfied
contented and free. The Receipts Adam Wolfson hath granted bargained sold
aliened enfeoffed released sitom released and confirmed and by these presents
doth grant bargain, sell alien enfeoff release sitom released and confirmed unto
the said Jordan Denson and to his heirs and assigns forever all that plantation
messuage tract and parcels of land whereon the said Adam Wolfson now living
and being all the land which the said Wolfson purchased of Her Majesty
George and being in the County of Southampton and Parish of St. Andrew's containing
by estimation one hundred and four acres, be the same more or less, and bounded according
to the known and reputed bounds thereof, also one bay more one blackish roan horse
two only two head of white cattle green skin and twenty three Shaggy four leg and four
mitten with all the remainder of my house hold and Household Furniture plantation
Inplements and tools of every kind also all my Crops (with that exception and
one happy article with four cups and worms and two legs, and also the interest of
the Interest claim and demand of him the said Adam Wolfson from and to
the same many parts several shares of share, and to hold the said
plantation messuage tract and parcels of one hundred and four acres of land
be the same more or less, and premises with all and every the opportunity
of use and the other granted, sold, bargained, goods and effects unto him the
