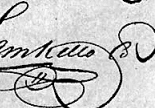

This Indenture made this 1st day of May 1799
between Ephraim Faircloth and Phoebe his wife of St. Mary's County of the
part, and James Wilkinson of the other part, Witnesseth that the said
Ephraim Faircloth for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty pounds
in hand paid by the said James Wilkinson hath bargained sold
aliened and by these presents doth bargain sell aliened and
confirm unto the said James Wilkinson and to his heirs forever one
Tract of Land lying in the Parish of St. Lukes and in the County
aforesaid containing by estimation sixty acres and bounded as follows
beginning at a Hickory a corner in the Vineyard line thence along the
said line to Benjamin Gray line in several places to a spring in
the prong of said branch, thence down said branch to a maple
