This INDENTURE made this 1st day of May 1799
Between Ephraim Faircloth and Phoebe his wife of St. Amrys County first
part, and James Wilkinson of the other part, witnesseth that the said
Ephraim Faircloth for an consideration of the sum of Eighty pounds
in hand paid by the said James Wilkinson hath bargained sold &
agreed and by these presents doth bargain sell alien enfeoff and
convey unto the said James Wilkinson and to his heirs forever one
tract of Land lying in the Parish of St. Lukes and in the County
aforesaid containing by estimation Sixty acres and bounded as follows
Beginning at a hickory a common tree thence two thousand along the
said line to Benjamin Gray's line in a small branch to open in
the prong of said branch thence down said branch to a maple
