between Dorcas Deas and Joshua Williams of the one part and James
Wilkinson of the other part Witnesseth that the said Dorcas
and Joshua for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred
dollars in hand paid by the said James Wilkinson the receipt of
which is hereby acknowledged by the said Dorcas and Joshua with
hargama Sato and Delianus and by these presents doth sell &
convey unto the said James Wilkinson his heirs &c and certain
heirs of Law being and being in the County of St. James County
one hundred and ninety seven acres which said tract of land
was conveyed to the said Wilkinson by Henry Crafford and Robert
Williams the bounds of which will fully appear by reference to the
and to have and to hold the said land and all the appurten-
ances thereto belonging to the only proper use and behoof of him the
said Wilkinson his heirs &c forever and the said Dorcas Deas & Joshua
Williams for themselves their heirs and with force now and to defend the title of the
said Land &c against all persons whatsoever In Testimony whereof the
said Dorcas Deas and Joshua Williams have hereunto set their hands
