This Indenture made this 8th day of July in the
year of our Lord 1805 Between Sutors John William Doan
and Nancy Doan of the County of Switzercompton and Parish of
Nottingham and Gaty Woodwards of the County and Parish aforesaid
Whitpette that the said Sutors John William Doan & Nancy Doan
joint heirs of Sarah Doan Deceased for and in consideration of the sum of
two hundred and Twenty five dollars to them in hand paid by the
said Gaty Wood and the receipt whereof the said Sutors John William
Doan and Nancy Doan with happy Acknowledges have and
each of them hath by these presents do and each of them with great
bargain full alien alien release and confirmation to the said Gaty
Wood and to his heirs forever all that part or parcel of land
and premises with all the appurtenances Situated Lying and being
in the parish of Nottingham and County of Swampton containing
by estimation one hundred and twenty acres be the same more or less
and bounded as followeth (to wit) Beginning at a history stone
standing in Joseph Densons line and at corner of Williams Doan
line thence along said Doan line to a point standing near a large
path thence along the said Path to the road, thence up the road
to Starling branch thence down the various courses of the said
branch Joshua Whiting line thence along the said Whiting line
