This Indenture made this 18th day of November in the year
 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and five, between Peter Mary and
 Rebecca his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part, and
 Lewis Harris of the County of the other parts. Witnesses that the said
 Peter Mary and Rebecca his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of
 four hundred and eighty dollars to them in hand paid or deemed to be paid,
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Peter Mary and
 Rebecca his wife have bargained and sold, and by these presents doth
 bargain and sell unto the said Lewis Harris his heirs and assigns a
 certain tract, piece or parcel of Land lying and being in the said County
 of Southampton on the South side of the River Creek, in the Great
 Swamp, it being apart of the Land the said Peter Mary purchased
 of Joseph Harrison, containing by late survey Sixty six, to
 the same more or less, and bounded as follows, to wit: Beginning at
 a red Oak at 1/4 E. 85 poles to a Persimmon tree at an old
 dam, thence N. 8 E. 84 poles to the new road, thence down the said
 Road thence down the said Road, until it intercepts the said Lewis
 Harris line, thence S. 3 E. West 17 3/4 poles along said Harris line
 to the Beginning; together with all and singular the appurtenances
 therunto belonging or in any manner appertaining. To have
 and to hold the said Sixty six acres of Land with all and singular
 the aforesaid bargained premises and every part and parcel thereof with
 the other right, tenements and appurtenances unto the said Lewis Harris
 his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof
 of him the said Lewis Harris his heirs and assigns forever, and
 the said Peter Mary and Rebecca his wife for themselves and
 their heirs the said Land and premises before mentioned unto the said
 Lewis Harris his heirs and assigns, free from the Claim or Demand
 of them or either of them their heirs and assigns and every person claiming
 whatsoever, shall, will, and do warrant and defend by these presents
