To all to whom these presents shall come greeting know ye that I, James Folke of the County of Southampton for divers good Causes me hereby moving do hereby emancipate and set free the negro Person named George and I do for my self my heirs executors and administrators hereby emancipate and set free the aforesaid negro and I do forever quit claim to all right which I have had or may hereafter have to the benefit of the said negro or any property he may hereafter acquire by any means whatsoever And forever warrant and Defend the right and title of the said negro to his freedom from the claim or claiming of all and every this person or persons whatsoever = Attest my hand and the seal of the said Court the 30th day of April 1806. Signed sealed and delivered in the presence of us
