This Indenture made this Fifth day of April

in the year of our Lord 1806, Between Daniel Boykin and  
Nancy his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and  
Joshua Womble of the County aforesaid of the other part witnesseth  
that the said Daniel Boykin and Nancy his wife for and in  
consideration of the sum of Sixty four pounds, like Shillings &  
Eight pence to them in hand paid by the said Joshua Womble  
at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents to  
Receipt whereof the said Daniel Boykin and Nancy his  
wife hath granted bargained and sold all unto us aforesaid and confirmed  
unto the said Joshua Womble his heirs and assigns forever one certain  
tract or parcels of land containing twenty four acres lying and  
being on the County of Hampton being a part of a tract bought by  
the said Daniel Boykin by his father as follows to the West (to the West)  
Beginning at the corner of the said Womble's land in Charles  
Baileys line then w along the said Baileys line thirtieth four  
acres East thirty nine poles to first rock, then w, leaving the said  
Baileys line along a new line of marked trees 400' 13' East 54 pole  
to a pine then w on west 15' West 38 pole to a pine then w  
South Eighty five degrees West, thirty six pole to a pine corner  
tree of said Womble's land then w north ten degrees West thirty five  
pole to a red oak corner tree, thence South 30' West to another oak  
in the be Branch, thence down the various courses of the branch to  
the back in Womble's line, thence along Womble's line to the  
Beginning, and the reserving and reserving remainder and remain-  
der rents and services of the said premises, also all the rents  
right, title, interest, claim and demands of the said Daniel  
Boykin and Nancy his wife and their heirs, son or to the  
same Land and premises, and every part and parcel thereof  
To have and to hold the said land and premises with the  
appurtenances herein before mentioned unto the said Joshua  
Womble his heirs and assigns forever, and the said Daniel  
Boykin and Nancy his wife for themselves their heirs and  
assigns and from all and every other person and persons  
whatsoever, claiming or demanding the said land &  
premises with their several and former Dignity unto the
