At a court held for the County of Southampton the 1st day of
May 1806 This indenture was acknowledged by Thomas
Washington party thereto and Received to be recorded Sam'l Miller Esq

This Indenture made this 16th day of May in
the year of our Lord 1806 Between Anthony Andrews and Mary
his wife of Southampton County of the one part and Thomas Washington
of the same County of the other part of Massachusetts. That the said
Anthony Andrews and Mary his wife for and consideration of the sum
of forty four pounds current money of Virginia to them in hand
paid by the said Thomas Washington the receipt whereof they the said
Anthony Andrews and Mary his wife doth hereby acknowledge have
granted Bargained sold and by these presents doth grant
bargain and sell all mycuffe and Cufum unto the said Thomas
Washington his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcels of
land containing by estimation fifty acres to the same more or
less situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and
bounded as follows (cont'd) Beginning at a white Oak on John Brittle
and wife Cannell line thence along the said Cannell line to a pine
a boar tree on a narrow Branch line thence along the said Branch
line to a pine on the Washington line thence along said Washington
line to a white oak on Jonathan Broken line thence along said broken
line to a pine on John Brittle line thence along said Brittle line
to the Beginning It HAVING AND THE Tenth the day of June
one thousand eight hundred and six the premises herein before mentioned are granted
to be thirty years, with the usual and accustomed remuneration and rem-
ainder rent and profits of the premises, also all the estate right title
Interest claim and demands of them the said Anthony Andrews
and Mary his wife their heirs and assigns of all the said land
and premises and every part thereof with the appurtenances therin
before mentioned unto the said Thomas Washington his heirs and
assigns forever. And the said Anthony Andrews and Mary his
wife for themselves and their heirs and gien all and every other per-
sons whatsoever claiming or demanding the said Land
and premises do hereby warrant and give over to find unto that
