The Communicate of Virginia to the
Honorable William Dabney, Gentleman Justice of the peace
for the County of Southampton greeting, whereas Samuel Kitchin
and Rebecca his wife have by their certain Indenture of bargain
and sale dated the 1st day of January 1806 conveyed unto John
Washington of the County of Southampton the full simple
Estate of and in fifty nine and a half acres of Land near Kenosha
that whereas the said Rebecca cannot conveniently travel
to the Court of our said County to acknowledge the same
therefore we do give to you power to receive the acknowledgment
which the said Rebecca shall be willing to make before
you of the conveyance aforesaid contained in the said Indenture
which is hereto annexed, and we do therefore Command you
to go personally to the said Rebecca and examine her privately
and apart from her husband whether she hath received the said
and fully and voluntarily without the persuasion or threat
of her said husband and whether she is willing the said
Indenture be recorded in the County Court of Southampton and
when you have examined her as aforesaid, and taken her an
affidavit of the same, that you do return and openly certify
with your own hand and seal returning to the said
Court of our said County the 2nd day of March 1806 and in the
