This Indenture made this twenty third day of
November in the year of our Lord 1808 Between Mark Suckins
of Southampton County of the one part and William West of
the said County of the other part, Witnesseth that the said
Mark Suckins for and in consideration of the sum of two
hundred and ninety nine pounds, Sixteen Shillings and three pence
to him in hand paid by the said William West at or before the
Sealing and Delivering of these presents the receipt whereof the said
Mark Suckins doth hereby acknowledge he the said Mark
Suckins hath granted bargained and sold Aligned and Confirmed
and by these presents doth grant grant bargain and sell
alien Enfeoff and Confirm unto the said William West
one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the
County of Southampton and parish of Medbury containing
one hundred and ninety two acres (more or less) and bounded
by the Land of James North Brittain Francis Anselm
Lewis's and the light wood swamp, reference being had to the
Thirtie mile fully Appen and the reversion and reversions remain-
-an and remain day rent and Service of the said Premises
long paid thereof, and also all the estate right title Interest
claim and demand whatsoever of them the said Mark
Suckins of in and to the said premises and every part thereof
To have and to hold all and singular the said
premises above mentioned and every and parcel thereof with
the Appurtenances unto the said William West his heirs and
assigns forever; and the said Mark Suckins for himself and
his heirs the said Lands and Premises and every part thereof
against himself and his heirs and against all and every
other person and persons whatsoever to the said William
West his heirs and assigns shall and will remain and ever
