

This Indenture made this 31st day of March in the year
 of our Lord 1806 between Robert Maly and Rebecca his wife
 of the County of Southampton of the one part and James Lindsay of
 the said County of the other parts, Witnesseth that the said Robert
 Maly and Rebecca his wife, in consideration of one hundred and
 Sixty pounds four Shillings lawful money of the Commonwealth
 to them in hand paid by the said James Lindsay at or before the
 sealing and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged) Have granted, bargained and sold, and by
 these presents do, and each of them doth, bargain and sell unto the
 said James Lindsay his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel
 of Land, Situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton
 on the North Side of Methuen, being apart of a tract of Land which
 formerly belonged to William Little dec^d. Containing one hundred
 and Seventy three acres, be the same more or less, and bounded
 as follow. Beginning at said oak in the said James Lindsay's line,
 thence North twenty two degrees E. 14 9 poles, to a white oak on the
 road, thence N. 38.5 along Lemoford Lindsay's line fifty two poles
 to two small white oaks, thence thence S. 22. W. 140 poles
 to two oaks oak in the said James Lindsay's line, thence N. 77
 W. 134 poles, to another oak in the said James Lindsay's line,
 thence S. 37.5 West to the Pratterson Branch, thence down the
 various courses of said Branch to the said Lindsay's line, thence
 along the said Lindsay's line N. 57.5 E. to a white oak, thence
 S. 28. W. 83 poles, along the said Lindsay's line, to another oak
 oak, thence South fifty seven degrees, East. 32 poles along the said
 Lindsay's line to a willow oak, thence N. 56. East. 148 poles
 along the said Lindsay's line to another oak thence South
 E 52 poles to the Beginning. Together with all and singular
 the appurtenances therunto belonging, or in anywise appur-
 taining, and the reversion and reversion remainders, and remainder
 year and other rents, issues and profits thereof. To have and
 to hold the said tract of Land and premises with the tenements
 and all and singular other the premises, hereinafter
