Know all men by these presents that I Richard Clamont of
the County of Southampton Trustee in a Deed being date the 26th
of March 1801, between Owen Myricks of the aforesaid
County of the other part and Henry Barrow and William
Chambliss of the aforesaid County of the other part Witnesseth
that for and in Consideration of the purposes being answered and
Completed in which the said deed in trust was executed to me
(to wit) For the payment of a debt due the said Henry Barrow
from the said Owen Myricks of one hundred and forty six
pounds six shillings and five pence, and another Debt to the
said William Chambliss of one hundred and forty pounds
shillings; which two Sums are now fully paid and discharged,
and for the further Sum of one Dollar to me returned being the
Annua Consideration money by me paid to the said said Myricks.
I do for my self my heirs executors administrators and assigns by these
presents forever relinquish to Just Clarin and his assigns up to
the said Owen Myricks his Executors administrators or assigns the
Part of Land so conveyed to me in trust, as above expressed
being five hundred Acres more or less, and bounded as follows
(To wit) Beginning at a pine a Corner dividing between Bay
Bourham and Peter Simmons then along the said Simmons's
line to a corner of the Estate of Samuel Myricks Junr then along
the said John Myricks line to a pine a Corner of the Estate
of Drury Parkers then along the said Parkers to a
