This Indenture made the 13th day of January
in the year 1806 between Mills Laurence and Patsy Laurence
his wife of Isle of Wight County of the one part and Mills Hatfield
of Southampton County of the other part Witnesseth that the
said Mills Laurence and Patsy Laurence his wife in consideration
of the sum of Sixty pounds Lawful money to them then and
paid by the said Mills Hatfield at or before the executing of these
presents the receipt whereof is hereby Acknowledged have bargained and
sold, and by these presents do make over of us with bargain and sell
into full and sole the Mills Hatfield his heirs and assigns a certain tract of
Land lying on black water in Southampton County and containing
by Estimation one hundred and ten acres, more or less and bounded
as follows Beginning at a white oak that stand in Jacks branch
thence along a line of marked trees boundaries on the Paper line to a
Pine standing on the Edge of the run of Cypress Swamp, thence
across the said Swamp to John Laurences line thence along said
Laurences line of marked trees a Cross the Muddy branch
thence it crosses the the Island to the Whiting line (i.e.) thence
along the bank of the bank of the Island to black water river, thence
across said river to the mouth of the Cypress Swamp, thence up said
Swamp to the mouth of Snakes branch, thence up said branch
to the white oak the first Station, Together with all and every other
Appurtenances thereto or any more belonging unto the said Mills
Hatfield his heirs and assigns forever free from the Claims of the
said Mills Laurence and Patsy his wife either of them their heirs
or their heirs and assigns. In Witness whereof the said Mills Laurence
