delivered unto him the said Lewis Wmells a certain negro girl named
Charlotte with all her future increase which said Charlotte with other papers
as hereto before conveyed by deed of Gift bearing date the 2nd day
of December 1803 executed by said Edwards to said Williams as for
my self my heirs and all my representation, release and Quit Claim to
the said negro Charlotte unto the said Wmells and unto said Edwards
as for my self my heirs and all my representation grants the right
and title of the said negro to the said Wmells against the claims
or demands of all persons to whomsoever = In Witness Whereof we
have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals the 2nd day of
December 1803
