

This Agreement made entered into and concluded this 10th day
 of November 1805 between William Clark of the County of Edgecombe
 North Carolina of the one part and Ethelena Vapor of the County of
 Southampton in the State of Virginia of the other part: We therefore
 that the said William Clark for and in Consideration of one thousand
 dollars to be then in hand paid by the said Ethelena Vapor, the receipt
 whereof the said Clark doth hereby acknowledge, have bargained
 and sold and by these presents do bargain sell and deliver unto the
 said Ethelena Vapor, all that part of Franklins Blackes de &c
 devised on by the Last will and testament of the said Franklins Blackes
 (my father) Consisting of one Eighteenth part of the said whole Estate
 Consisting of Land negroes, and white other of his estate of what
 nature of quality seems To have and to hold the said Eight
 part of said Estate to him and his heirs forever and the said William
 Clark for himself and his heirs, do and shall for ever warrant and
 defend by this presents all my right and title in said Estate, to him the
 said Ethelena Vapor his heirs and assigns forever: In Witness
