This indenture made this 17th day of May 1806, between

John Bishop of the one part and Messrs Bishop of another part, unto James Bishop of the third part all of Southampton County, Wiltshire doth shew that the said John Bishop and Messrs Bishop for and in consideration of the sum of fifty five pounds current money of Virginia hath granted and by this presents doth grant and convey unto the said James Bishop his heirs and assigns a certain Tract or parcel of land by Estimation containing Sixty two acres and $\frac{1}{2}$ more or less; and bounded as followeth, by the line of Daniel Beal on the South the line of the heirs of John Rockwell on the West by Daniel Beal and the aforesaid Ephraim on the North and Sumner Beal and Henry Beal on the East. It being a part of the Tract which John Bishop didd Sign and possessed of with all houses out houses, garden, orchards meadows water and water courses roads and enclosures and mines and all profits and Commodities Hereditamentary and appurtenances thereunto belonging and in any way appertaining. To have and to hold the said premises with all its appurtenances unto the said James Bishop his heirs and assigns forever with the reversion and reversioning remainder and remainder thereof, and the said John Bishop and Messrs Bishop for themselves, their heirs Executors and administrators doth Covenant and agree with the said James Bishop his heirs and assigns, in the following Manner (that is to say) that the said John Bishop at the time of signing and sealing this presents is fully possessed of these aforesaid premises, and that the same is fully and clearly acquitted of and free from all manner of incumbrances whatsoever, and that the said John Bishop and Messrs Bishop doth hereby warrant and defend the aforesaid premises against themselves their heirs &c against the Lawfull Claims of all and every persons and persons whatsoever and whomever, unto the said James Bishop his heirs and assigns forever.
