This Indenture made this 29th day of July in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and five Between George Serley Thomas and Hannah his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Henry Thomas of the County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said George Serley Thomas and Hannah his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand eight hundred and Fifty dollars to them in hand paid before the sealing and delivery hereof by the said Henry Thomas the receipt whereof they doth truly acknowledge and themselves fully satisfied & Contented and paid, hath given, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed, released, conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth for themselves their heirs, Executors & Administrators, fully fully and absolutely, give grant bargain and sell, alien, convey, release, convey and fully confirm unto the said Henry Thomas his heirs, executors and assigns forever, and certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid on the South side of Botolphay River, containing by Estimation two hundred and twenty three acres, be the same more or less, and bounded as follows To wit: Beginning at a certain white oak standing at the Head of the Spring thence along above of marked trees to a Grand a corner tree of John Thomas and Henry Thomas line in the head of a small branch, thence down the said branch to a large white oak, thence along above of marked trees to the great branch, thence down the said branch to Tokinathum two snarps thence down the said branch to the mouth of the deep branch, thence up the said branch to the beginning all the recesses and recesses, remainder and remainder, unto the said Henry Thomas his heirs and assigns forever and every part thereof, and all the waste right title claim and Demand whatsoever of them the said George & Thomas and Hannah his wife if it is and to the said said tract or parcel of land and every part thereof, I have and do hold the said said tract or parcel of Land and all and singular the premises above mentioned and every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances unto the said Henry Thomas his heirs and assigns forever, and the said George & Thomas and Hannah his wife for themselves and their heirs and that tract or parcel of Land and premises and every part thereof against their selves and their heirs and against all and every other person or persons who
