This Indenture made this 7th day of February in the
year of our Lord 1806 between William R. Holladay and
Mary his wife of Southampton County and parish of St. Peter of the one
Part and Henry Barron of the aforesaid County and Parish of the other part
Witnesseth that the said William R. Holladay and Mary his wife
for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars to them in
hand paid on or before the sealing and delivery of these presents whereby
whereof the said William and Mary doth hereby acknowledge their
granted, bargained, and sold aliened and confirmed unto the said
Henry Barron and to his heirs and assigns forever, or certain tract
or parcel of Land containing two hundred and twenty acres
lying on the South side of the three Creek (late the property of
Thomas Holladay Junior and bounded on falling point, beginning
at a maple above two of in Thomas Turner and Henry Barron line
thence along the said Turners line to a pine in Williams Fitzhugh's
line thence along Williams Fitzhugh's to a pine a corner tree South
side of the new road, thence up the said road to a great acorn in
