

Indenture made the 11th day of April one thousand
Eight hundred and Six Between Henry Doyal of the one part and Jacob Vick
of the other part both of the County of Southampton ~~Witnesseth~~ that
the said Henry Doyal for and in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds
in hand paid by the said Jacob at or before the Signing and Delivered of these
presents the receipt whereof the said Henry Doyal doth hereby acknowledge
- Bridge hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant
bargain and sell unto the said Jacob Vick a certain tract or parcel of land
lying and being in the County aforesaid and bounded as follow (viz) ~~beginning~~
Beginning at a black gum standing in the run of the great branch thence
by a line of marked trees to a live oak standing in the run of the Harp
branch thence down the run of the branch to the Flag run to the mouth of
the great branch to a Cypress a marked tree thence up the said branch
to the Beginning - Having the land which was conveyed by William Barnes
to said Henry Doyal as trustee to secure the payment of a Debt due from
the said Barnes to said Jacob Vick which said Debt of was duly paid &
recorded in the County Court of Southampton the 20th day of May 1805 -
To have and to hold the said tract and parcel of Land, and all and
Singular the premises above mentioned and every part thereof, with the appur-
tenances unto the said Jacob Vick his heirs and assigns, to the only proper use &
benefit of him the said Jacob Vick his heirs and assigns forever - and the said
Henry Doyal for himself his heirs &c. the said tract and parcel of Land and
every part thereof unto the said Jacob Vick his heirs and assigns and
against the claim of all and every other person or persons who shall come - And
Witnesseth that the said Henry Doyal and Jacob the day and year
above written
