Other Indenture made this 11th day of April, one thousand
Eight hundred and five - Between Harry Doyal of the one part and Jack Nick
of the other both of the County of Southampton - witnesseth that
the said Harry Doyal for and in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds
in hand paid by the said Jack as a before the Seales and Debating of this
present the receipt whereof the said Harry Doyal doth hereby acknowledge

- ridge hath granted bargained and sold and by this present doth grant
bargain and sell unto the said Jack Nick a certain tract or parcel of land
lying and being in the County aforesaid, and bounded as followeth
Beginning at a black gum standing in the rim of the great branch, thence
by a line of marked trees to a live oak standing in the rim of the branch
branch, thence down the rim of the branch to the first run to the mouth of
the great branch to a before a marked tree, thence up the said branch
to the Beginning - It being the land which was conveyed by William Bams
to said Harry Doyal as trustee to secure the payment of a debt due from
the said Bams to said Jack Nick which said Deed of was duly made &
recorded in the County Court of Southampton the 20th day of May 1805 -
To have and to hold the said tract and parcel of Land, and all and
Sundry appurtenances thereto mentioned and every part thereof, with the appur-
tenances unto the said Jack Nick his heirs and assigns, to the only proprie-
tary of him the said Jack Nick his heirs and assigns forever and the said
Harry Doyal to himself his heirs & executors and trustees and parcels of Land and
any part thereof unto the said Jack Nick his heirs and assigns and
against the claim of all and every other person or persons whatsoever for
the non payment of said sum of £50 - Let my heirs and I seal the day and year
above written
