by Thomas Gray of the County of Southampton the receipt whereof I do
acknowledge and my self fully paid and satisfied and of the same sum
I have paid them of do by these presents acquit and discharge the said Thomas
Gray his heirs and assigns forever and the said Edmund Wood of the County
of Southampton and have bargained sold made our transfers and
conveyance unto the said Thomas Gray then negro Slave named Anne Dick
and Sam used by the said Thomas Gray and do hereby transfer and deliver
unto the said Thomas Gray the said negro Slave Anne Dick and her
Offspring and to hold unto the said Thomas Gray his heirs and assigns
forever and I do the said Edmund Wood for my self my heirs and assigns
administering the said negro Slave Anne Dick and Sam
