This Indenture made and entered into the 20th day of January Anno Domini 1808 Between Willm. J. Dicks and Patience wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Thomas Draper of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Willm. J. Dicks and Patience his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Forty two pounds, and two pence Current Money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Draper the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold aliened, and do by this present bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said Thomas Draper his heirs and assigns, one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Henry containing by Estimation thirty three 1/2 and be the same more or less (being apart of the tract of Land, that formerly belonging to the nephew of Isaac Warner dead and which tract of land was sold by deed of conveyance bearing date 1803 and purchased by the said Willm. J. Dicks and bound as follows to wit Beginning at a white oak on the line between the said Dicks and another Hollmann, and along said line to a corner of said Hollmann and Fitchell, then along Fitchell line to a small water run in said Drapers line and along his line to a large pine near the Cotton house, thence a crop by a straight line to the oak begun at, with all his woods under and to be immediately advantages hereditaments and appurtenances what ever to the said tract or parcel of land above mentioned, belonging in any right appurtenant, and the reversion and reversionary remainder and remainder, rents and profits of the said premises and of every part
