Curly This Indenture made the 19th day of December in the year 1800 between Richard Blon Inmish Drake and Henry Thomas (Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Southampton to make sale of the lands of Jordan Edwards del.) of the one part and George Linley of the other parts, M. Sturges both, that the said Richard Blon &c Commissioners, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and seven pounds ten shillings current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said George Linley the receipt whereof the said Richard Blon &c hereby acknowledge, hath granted, bargained, sold, and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell, alien, enfeoff and confirm unto said George Linley his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation one hundred and sixteen acres more or less & bounded as follows, Beginning at a black oak then by a line of marked trees to a pine in a meadow then by 5 degrees north 12 5 poles to a white oak, then south W. by south 10 2 poles to a black oak then North twenty degrees E. 12 5 to a maple in the side of the head run Swamp then by a line of marked trees to a pine by the side of a small branch then the various courses of the run of said branch to the beginning, with all trees woods, underwoods common commons of Pasture or profits, commodities advantages, Emblements, & hereditaments whatsoever to the said plantation, or tract of land belonging or any wise appertaining, or upon the same growing, happening, or arising & also the reversion reversions remainders & remainders unto Services of the premises and every part thereof and also all the estate right title, interest claim & demand whatsoever of them the said Richard Blon &c (Commrs) of or to the said premises being past thereof To have and to hold all & singular the said premises unto the said mentioned and every part thereof with the appertinances unto the said
