Blackhead This Instrument made the 6th day of March in the year of our Lord
to 1806 Between Benjamin Blackhead of the County of Southampton &
Wade parish of Netting, of the one part and Mary Bonington Wade of the County
of Southampton of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Blackhead
for and in consideration of the sum of seven shillings, thirteen pence, four
pennies by the said Mary Bonington Wade on hand paid before the ex-
ecuting & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Benjamin
Blackhead doth hereby acknowledge & thereof acquit & discharge the
said Mary B. Wade her heirs & assigns forever & himself therewith fully &
entirely satisfied contented and paid and the said Benjamin Blackhead doth
grant bargain & sell release set over deliver and confirm and by
these presents doth grant bargain and sell all an yffore said set over delivery
and confirm unto the said Mary B. Wade and to her heirs forever all that
plantation meadow tract & parcel of land wherein Iman lies situated lying &
being in the County of Southampton & parish of Netting aforesaid containing
by estimation more or less be the same more or less and bounded
as follows (to wit) by Joseph Demerline on one side James Long and
Mary Long on the other sides being all the land that the said Benjamin
Blackhead bought of Mary Long & all the house and house & appurtenances
thereunto in anywise appertaining & the reversion & remainings
whereof & all the profits & commodities hereto & thereunto & appertaining
whenever belonging or in any wise appertaining & the reversion & remainings
whereof & all the profits & commodities thereof and all the estate right
title claim or demand of him the said Benjamin Blackhead of in & to
the same & every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the
said granted plantation meadow tract & parcel of land and premises with
all & singular & every of the appurtenances unto her the said Mary B.
Wade & to her heirs & assigns forever to the only use & behoof of her the said
Mary B. Wade & to her heirs & assigns forever against all & every person
claiming & demanding the same by law or equity
