Wills I understand well, made this 23rd day of July, in the year of
Lord 1806 Between John Collins of the County of Suffolk on the one part, & Benjamin
Warren of the County of Hampshire on the other part, witnesseth that the said John
Collins for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred dollars to him in hand
paid the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and confess, have granted
bargained and sold above expressed and confirmed and by these presents with grants
burgh and all other rights of ownership unto the said Benjamin Warren his
heirs & assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying & being
in the County of Southampton containing fifty acres be the same acre or less
and bounded as follows, beginning at the wooden bridge, thence along the main road
to Richard Blow's line, thence along said line to the main run of the big branch
thence down the main Run of said branch to the Bacon swamp, thence down
said swamp to the beginning together with all work ways, waters, and water
courses profits and advantages the same belonging or in any wise appertaining to
the ripples and ripples, ripples and ripples, rents, tithes and services thereunto
to him the said Benjamin Warren his heirs and assigns forever to the uses proper
just and behalf of him the said Benjamin Warren his and assigns forever 3d
have and to hold, the said tract or parcel of land and premises together with all
the right interest claims and demands of him the said John Collins his heirs and
assigns to him the said Benjamin Warren his heirs and assigns forever and the said
John Collins for himself and his heirs, the said tract of land and premises to the
said Benjamin Warren his heirs & assigns shall & will warrant and forever
defend to them, his heirs & assigns the claim and demand of every person & persons
whatsoever, In witness whereof the said John Collins hath hereunto set his
