Deforcant all and every other person or persons, what soever, claiming or demanding the said seven place & two acres of land, or any part or parcel thereof, within the above said term of seven years, shall and will we arrears, & defend, by their parents, In witness whereof, be the said Joshua Hines, hath hereunto set his hand and affixe his seal the day & year first above written.
