We have said to hold, all & singular the said premises above mentioned, belonging or in any ways appertaining unto the said William Kitchin his heirs & assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said William Kitchin, his heirs and assigns forever & the said tract &c. Davis certifies for himself & his heirs the said tract of land, and every part thereof against himself & his heirs & against all and every other person & persons whatsoever to the said William Kitchin his heirs & assigns forever. This Indenture, made this 2^d day of December, 1805, between Arthur Turner of the first part, Benjamin Barker of the second part, Spradley Williams of the third part, all of Southampton County, State of Virginia, Writingeth that whereas, the said Benjamin Barker, has lately, bound himself, for the said Arthur Turner as common bail, for his appearance at the District Court of Shoffolk to be then and there held in the month of October next, in a suit depending, in which Charles Barker is plaintiff against the said Arthur Turner defendant, in the sum of seven hundred pounds, Now this Indenture, Witnesseth, that the said Arthur Turner for and in consideration of the premises, as also for the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid, hath granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents, doth grant, bargain and sell, unto the said Spradley Williams the following property, to have him, negroes, James, John, Ben. Lane, Kinchen, Amos, Ben, Betty, & Daniel,
