W<sup>c</sup> I N D E M N I T Y. made this 25<sup>th</sup> day of March 1809. Between  
Henry Olney and Lydia his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part  
and Matthew Williams of the same County of the other part testifying that  
the said Henry Olney in consideration of the sum of Nine dollars to him  
in hand paid, or to be paid at or before sealing and delivery of this  
Deed presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has granted bargained  
sold alienated appurteyned conveyed and confirmed unto the said Matthew Williams  
all that piece or parcel of land in the County of Southampton containing  
by estimation two acres & a half more or less and bounded with the  
following boundaries, beginning at a white oak being a corner of Burrows  
Burrows line also a corner Matthew Williams line and Henry Olney's  
line starting near a small branch thereof up the run of said branch  
to a Maple a natural corner of said land in said branch, then  
leaving the said branch a straight line to a lightning post another natural  
corner of said land thence to a branch pine starting in a small branch in  
the above named Matthew Williams line whence the said line to the  
white oak being the first station, this is a part of a tract of land  
left the said Henry Olney by his father Thomas Olney in  
his last will and testament which was duly recorded in the  
County court of Southampton, and all houses, buildings w<sup>ay</sup>  
water, rights, tenements, and hereditaments, thereto belonging  
and the reversion and reversions, remainder and recompenses  
rents issues profits and emoluments thereof to have and  
to hold the said land and appurtenances unto the said Matthew  
Williams and his heirs forever in full and absolute free holding and the  
said Lydia Olney do hereby release renounce and give up unto the said  
Matthew Williams and his heirs and assigns all right title of whomsoever it  
right whereto which she now hath or shall or may hereafter have in it  
to the premises and the said Henry Olney warrants for himself and his  
heirs with the said Matthew Williams his heirs and assigns as follows
