said. They presents therefore sheweth that said Maclean before and in con-
sideration of the sum of three hundred & thirty dollars, cash in hand paid
him on the part of said Bailey, the receipt of which is a convincing and
acknowledged, hath bargained and sold, relinquished and transferred to and
in favor of said Bailey his heirs executors & administrators and by their
presents with now fully, absolutely and unconditionally as men-
tioned, bargained & sold, relinquish & transfer to said Bailey his heirs exec-
utors or assigns all the right, title, interest and benefit which said Maclean is
intitled or doows to him by his wife, being one fifth part, and also
all his right & title as devised by from said David Cummins, being one
other fifth part of the legacies to which said David & Maclean wife
were intitled, as legatees under the will of said Samuel Briggs & the
income which ~~was~~ was the object of the said compromise. and the said
Maclean with not only absolutely, sell, transfer & release all the title
interest and emolument to which he now is or can be intitled by
reason as afore-
said to said Bailey his heirs executors or assigns absolutely, but
with moreover, covenant and agree forthwith to dismiss the said compromise at
his own costs & reimburse said Bailey his executors and assigns absolutely
from all other and further expense trouble or mutation in regard to
