This Indenture made the 3rd day of March in the year of our Lord Christ 1806 between Elias Brashaw & Ely his wife of the county of Southampton and parish of Netley of the one part and Joseph Brashaw of the same county and parish of the other part Witnesseth that the said Elias Brashaw and Ely his wife for and in consideration of the sum and full sum of fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Joseph Brashaw the receipt whereof they the said Elias Brashaw & Ely his wife with their own acknowledgments and discharge the said Joseph his heirs and assigns forever and him up therewith fully and intirely satisfied contented and paid they the said Elias Brashaw and Ely his wife have granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released without addition and expence and by these presents with power to them sell alien enfeoff release situate situate and confirm unto the said Joseph Brashaw and to his heirs and assigns forever part of that plantation messuages tracts and parcels of land situate in the said Elias Brashaw and Ely his wife now lies situate lying and being in the county of Southampton and parish of Netley of the one part containing by estimation & more or less a half acre and bounded on the sides (its width) beginning at a post or corner in Mrs Brashaw and Joseph Brashaw's line thence along Joseph Brashaw's old line to a pine a corner tree thence a line that divides the said land from the other part of Mrs Brashaw's land to a red oak in Brashaw's line thence the said line to Joseph Brashaw's old line thence along the said line to the beginning and all the houses and houses & divers buildings in roads ways waters and water courses for so far as the same are or shall be and appurtenances and the reversions and remainders and cummings rights & profits thereof and all the estate right title interest claim and demand of them the said Elias Brashaw and Ely his wife in and to the same and every part and parcel thereof.
