our Lord Christ, one thousand eight hundred six, between Jeremiah Sympson

one part and Matthew Camp of the other part, is witnessed that the said Jeremiah
Sympson and Eleanor his wife for and in consideration of the sum of eleven pounds
current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Matthew Camp the
receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge have and each of them hath and by
these presents do and each of them doth grant bargain sell alien release and
confirm unto the said Matthew Camp and to his heirs and assigns forever a certain
tract and parcel of land and premises with the appurtenances, situate lying &
being in the County of Southampton and parish of Netley aforesaid, containing by
estimate or twenty two acres, be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit
beginning at a red oak in Charles Rimmis line thence along a line of newly
marked trees through the old field to a pine a corner between the said Jeremiah
Sympson & Matthew Camp thence along a line of newly marked trees in the said
old field to Williams Monells line to a pine thence along the said Monells
line to a post oak a corner tree in the line called Kings Land thence along
a line of marked trees to the first station, and all that tract or parcel of land
and premises with the appurtenances adjoining and contiguous to the aforesaid
mentioned tract of land, and all houses, out houses, edifices buildings, yards, gardens
trees, woods, water courses, water courses, profits, commodities, hereditaments &
appurtenances whatsoever to the same tract or parcel of land belonging or in any
wise appertaining, and the recesses and recesses, remainders and remainders, rents
issues and profits thereof, and all the estate rights title, interest, use, trusts, profits
reversions, profits, claims and demands whatever of the said Jeremiah Sympson and
