This Indenture, made this 18th day of March, in the year of our
 Lord, one thousand eight and six, between William Hart of Southampton
 County of the one part, and William Bailey of the aforesaid County of the other
 part, Witnesseth, that the said William Hart for & in consideration of
 the sum of two hundred shillings to him in hand paid by the said William Bailey
 the receipt whereof the said William Hart hath freely acknowledged, he the said
 William Hart hath granted, conveyed and sold, aliened, released & confirmed
 and by these presents doth grant, convey & sell also release & confirm unto the
 said William Bailey, his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel
 of land containing one hundred acres be the same more or less, lying siting
 in the County of Southampton aforesaid, being the land devised to the said
 William Hart by the last Will & testament of his father John Hart deceased
 reference being thereunto had, well more fully appears, and also all trees, woods
 and woods, commons, common, & pastures profits, common rights, appurtenances
 & hereditaments, whatsoever to the said tract or parcel of land above
 mentioned & belonging or in any wise appertaining or in or upon the said
 growing, happening or arising and also the reversions & successions, remainders, tenements
 rents & services of the said premises and every part thereof and also all the right
 right, title, interest, claim & demand whatsoever of him the said William
 Hart, of or to the same premises and every part thereof. To have & to hold
 all and singular the said premises above mentioned and every part & parcel
 thereof with the appurtenances unto the said William Bailey, his heirs &
 assigns forever, & the said William Hart for himself & his heirs the
 said tract of land, and every part thereof against him & his heirs & assigns
 all and every other person & persons whatsoever the said William Bailey
