

212 Mary shall be willing to make before you of the conveyance of said contents
in the said Indenture which is hereto annexed. And now so command you to go pursuant
to the said Mary and examine her privately and apart from her husband, whether
he hath exacted the said debt fully and voluntarily without the persuasion or
threat of her husband: and whether she is willing the same should be recorded
in the County Court of Southampton, And when you have examined her as aforesaid
and later her acknowledgments of the same that you distinctly and openly certify
us thereof, under your hands and seals, returning to us also this writ with the

of its execution was returned & ordered to be recorded.
