Now all men by these presents that Shadrach Griffin of Southampton
County and State of Virginia in order to secure the payment of a debt due
from him to John Lee of the sum of four hundred and one dollars & thirty
three cents and thence from the present date, the said Shadrach Griffin
with hereby covenant contract and secured to be paid by or before the
first day of August 1807 ensuing, the date of these presents & for and in
consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by Sack Darden before the
making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof he with hereby acknowledge,
he the said Shadrach Griffin, hath granted bargained & sold, by these
presents, with great bargain and sell to him the said Sack Darden one negro man
Slave, Abram, one small mare, two feather beds and furniture, one pair of
Iron bound cart wheels, one saw eight shute, one duck and one tattle, to him
the said Sack Darden his heirs, assigns forever upon the following
trust, that is to say, that if default shall be made in the payment
of the above debt and interest by the said first day of August 1807, that it
shall and may be lawful and proper for him the said Sack Darden, his heirs
or assigns as soon as convenient by he or they can first giving at least ten days
notice by written advertisement of the time and place of sale to persons to
sell the said negro Abram, one small mare, two beds of furniture, one pair
Iron bound cart wheels, one saw eight shute, one duck and one tattle, to
the highest bidder for ready money, and out of the money so raised first to
pay & satisfy all costs and charges which in the said Sack Darden may
