This Indenture made this sixth day of December in the
year of Christ Eighteen hundred six, between William Read & Miriam his wife
of the county of Southampton of the one part, and William Bryant Junior of the same
county on the other part, Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the sum
of five hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said William Bryant
before the execution and delivery of these presents, have granted bargained and sold
and by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell, alien, and confirm unto him the said
William Bryant, a certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in the
aforesaid County of Southampton, and containing one hundred and fifty acres be the
same more or less, and bounded as follows to wit: Beginning at a black gum tree
on the state line in a prong of the cedar branch, thence up the said branch to a
pine in Nathan Bates line, thence along said line to a pine a corner in said
Bates line, thence to a black Jack tree, thence along said line to the beginning
It have and to hold, the said tract of land together with the premises & all
any way of the appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said William
Bryant his heirs and assigns forever, and they the said William Read & Miriam his
wife as by these presents, for themselves their heirs & representatives, do warrant
and will forever defend unto him the said Bryant his heirs & representatives
all right, title, interest and property in and to the said land & its appurtenances.
