This Indenture made and entered into this 14<sup>th</sup> day of Feby  
 in the year of our Lord 1807 between Thomas Barnes of the County of Southampton  
 of the one part and Jacob Barnes of the same County of the other part witnesseth  
 that the said Thomas Barnes for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars to  
 him in hand paid by the said Jacob Barnes at or before the making and delivery of  
 these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold  
 and by these presents do offer him and his heirs and all unto the said Jacob  
 Barnes his heirs and assigns a certain parcel of land lying and being in the County  
 of Southampton and bounded as follows, to wit Beginning at a red oak at  
 corner of Benjamin Barnes Line also a tree on Jacob Barnes line thence along  
 Jacob Barnes line Northwesterly course to a south prong of Second branch  
 thence up said branch about twenty pole to a Southwesterly prong of said  
 branch thence up said prong to a light wood tree in the head of said prong  
 thence a line of marked trees near a west course to a post set up in Benj:  
 Barnes line thence near north along said Barnes Line to the begining which  
 boundary contain about thirty acres together with all its appurtenances advantages  
 incidentals hereditaments appertaining thereto whetherso to the said land belongs or  
 appertains and the ruminant incumbrances remainderd remains now of profit or  
 thence. It shall and to helpe the said land and every part thereof unto the said Jacob  
 Barnes his heirs and assigns for ever for the only purpose and behf of him  
 the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns for to the said Thomas Barnes for him  
 self & his heirs to the said thirtynine acres of land with all its appurtenances unto  
 the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of him the  
 said Thomas Barnes his or his heirs and all & every power or power whatsoever  
 shall will & do warrant and forever defend by these presents In witness whereof  
 the said Thomas Barnes hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day &  
 year first above written -
