our Lord 1807 Steven Thophilus Daugtry and Lucrey his wife, of the
County of Isle of Wight of the one part and Etelton by and of this County of Hampshire
of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Thophilus Daugtry and Lucrey his wife
for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars current money of Virg:
already or here paid by the said Etelton & Lucrey the receipt of which I, sum
the said Thophilus Daugtry & Lucrey his wife doth hereby acknowledge them
satisfactorily satisfied, have bargained sold & set over & delivered by these
presentes as bargain sell set over & delivered unto the said Etelton & Lucrey his heirs
and assigns forever, a certain tract or parcel of land by me and being in the
County of Southampton, beginning at the road that lead from South Quay to
Dunstan's house N 67° E 25 p pole to a red oak in the said line then S
34° E 82 p pole thence N 63° E 25 pole to the branch called the Indian branch
then to the various courses of the said branch to a pine, a corner of said line then S
30° E 82 p pole to a white oak a corner of Etelton's garden land thence N 81°
W 52 pole, thence S 57° W 40 pole, thence S 57° W 44 pole thence S 70°
W 40 pole to the above mentioned road thence the various courses of the road
to the first station the said tract or parcel of land containing one hundred
þ two acre more or less together with all & singular the lands, tenements profits
communitie & hereditaments thereon or thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining
and all & singular the various and numerous mowings and remanents & all temporalies
the estate right title interest claim & demands of them the said Thophilus Daugtry
and Lucrey his wife their executors & administrators forever to have and to hold
the said several premises to the said Etelton & Lucrey his heirs and assigns forever
and to the only proper use & benefit & belief of him the said Etelton & Lucrey from
and the said Thophilus Daugtry & Lucrey his wife for themselves & their
heirs the said parcel of land with all the appurtenances above mentioned being
part thereof against him & his heirs and assigns all & every other person or persons
