Baykin This Indenture made the 15th day of May 1805 between Joel Baykin and Sarah Baykin his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and To David Baykin of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Joel Baykin and Sarah his wife for and in consideration of the sum of five shillings current money of Virginia the then in hand, at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Joel Baykin and Sarah Baykin his wife with hands acknowledged themselves fully satisfied contented and paid, have granted bargain'd sold alien'd and confirm'd and by these presents and great bargain sell alien in full and confirm unto the said David Baykin and to his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land and premises with the appurtenances situate lying & being in the County of Southampton containing by estimation two hundred and fifty acres more or less and bounded by, to wit (to wit) Beginning at a poplar & marked tree standing near the head of Parapin branch thence along a line of marked trees to a post oak a corner tree of Arthur Dokes and Joel Baykins thence along a line of marked trees to a small maple a corner tree of Joel Baykins standing in the rear of branch thence down the said branch into another branch called Hatfield's branch thence up the Hatfield's branch to a black gum a corner tree of Joel Baykins and David Baykin thence along a line of marked trees to a sweet gum of Daniel Baykins a corner tree of Joel Baykins and David Baykin thence along a line of marked trees to a large pine a corner tree of Daniel Baykins and Joshua Womble thence along a line of marked trees to a post oak a corner tree of David Baykin and Joshua Womble thence along a line of marked trees to a post oak standing at the Meadow branch a corner tree of Daniel Baykin Charles Bayley & David Baykin thence down the said Meadow branch into a branch called Parapin swamp thence up the said Parapin Swamp to the Beginning Also all woods and woods ways water & water courses with all profits commodities and advantages whatsoever to the same belonging now any wise appurtenant and also the
