This Indenture, made this 27th day of November 1806, between
 Dism Ketchum of the County of Southampton of the one part and William Washington of
 the said County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Dism Ketchum for & in consideration
 of the sum of Twenty seven pounds ten shillings & nine pence current money of Virginia
 to him in hand paid at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt
 of which the said Dism Ketchum doth hereby acknowledge himself fully satisfied con-
 tained and paid, hath granted bargain'd sold alien'd conveyed & confirmed by these presents
 unto William Washington his heirs & assigns forever all that tract of land & premises
 his heirs or assigns forever all that tract of land & premises, Beginning at a black oak a corner
 stone lying in being in the County aforesaid, Beginning at a black oak a corner
 tree of William Washington and said Dism Ketchum, then along a line of marked trees
 to a white oak a corner tree of said Washington & said Ketchum thence along a
 line of marked trees to a corner a oak adjoining Burgess's line, thence along a line
 of marked trees to a Gum in the pond bound a corner of Thomas Ketchum's line, thence
 along a line of marked trees to the Beginning, also all woods and woods ways water courses
 and all profits Commodities and advantages whatsoever to the same belonging or in any
 appertaining & also the rivers and running, remains & rivers & services of & premises
 and every part and parcel thereof and also all the estate right title interest claim or
 demand whatsoever of him the said Dism Ketchum of or to the same premises, &
 every part thereof. He have and to hold all & singular the said premises above
 mentioned & every part of parcel thereof, with the appertinances unto the said
 William Washington his heirs & assigns to the only proper use & behoof of
 him the said William Washington his heirs & assigns forever and I do hereby further
 confirm promise and grants to and with the said Washington his heirs & assigns
 the said land & every part & parcel thereof is free & clear from all other gifts
 grants mortgages and all other mortgages or Incumbrances whatsoever, in which
 I do hereby transfer myself, my heirs & assigns to warrant & defend the myself of all &
 singular the premises together with the appertinances unto him the said William Wash-
 ington his heirs & assigns forever against all & every other person or persons shall &
 will so want & forever defend by these presents, In Witness whereof I the said
 Dism Ketchum have hereunto set my hand & seal this 27th day of November 1806
