Do all people to whom these presents shall come, I Samuel Hicks do
and granting know ye that I the said Samuel Hicks of Southampton County for
and consideration of the love good will & affection which I have and do have
towards my loving daughter Patsy Hicks of the same County have given and granted
and by these presents do fully give and grant unto the said Patsy Hicks her heirs
and assigns forever all and sundry my goods & chattels household furniture and
stock of all kind consisting horses cattle sheep &c. &c. and also my
right of the negroes I have possession of, and my right to the lands and
premises of which before the signing of these presents I have given to her the said
Patsy Hicks an inventory signed with my own hand bearing word date to
have and to hold all the said goods and chattels and property chiefly of which
has been mentioned to her the said Patsy Hicks her heirs and assigns forever
from forth as hers and their property absolutely without any challenge claim
or demand by and the said Samuel Hicks, or of any other person or persons
for me or in my name by any Courts claims or demands and further know ye
that I the said Samuel Hicks have put the said Patsy Hicks in full possession
of all the property aforesaid by the delivery of the same unto her at the
inventing thereof. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
Seal this 16th day of February 1807.

This Indenture made this 15th day of January 1807 Between Jack
Mauling and Louisa his wife of Southampton County of the one part & Rebecca
Simmons of the aforesaid County of the other parts Witnesseth that the said Jack
Mauling and Louisa his wife have for and in consideration of the sum of
one dollar to them in hand paid by the said Rebecca Simmons the receipt
whereof they authorably acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the
said Rebecca Simmons, granted bargained sold and delivered unto her the said
Rebecca one certain tract piece or parcel of land lying and being in the
County of Hampton aforesaid containing by survey one hundred of acres more
or less but be the same more or less and being that said land or piece
