

This Indenture, made this 12th day of February 1807, between Etheldreda
 Gardner and Lydia his wife of Southampton County and State of Virgⁿ: of the one part
 and Theophilus Daugtrey of Isle of wight County and State of Virgⁿ: of the other part
 witnesseth that the said Etheldreda Gardner and Lydia his wife for ever in consideration
 of the sum of Eight hundred dollars current money of Virginia to them in hand
 paid the receipt the said Etheldreda Gardner and Lydia his wife with herby
 doth acknowledge the said Etheldreda Gardner and Lydia his wife have granted, bargained
 and sold allmā and confirmed unto the said Theophilus Daugtrey his heirs and assigns for
 1816 a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton and bounded
 as follows: To wit, beginning at a large pine at corner tree of William Baker's line north
 forty seven degrees West thirty six poles to a small branch thence the various courses of
 the said branch to a pine leaving the branch in Mary Mottry's line, then north sixty three
 degrees west thirty six poles to an oak, in the said Mottry's line, then north Eighty
 two degrees west thirty five poles to a white oak a corner tree of Mary Mottry's
 having on the side of a small branch, then the various courses of the said branch to a
 black gum standing on the sum of the corner then the various courses of the corner
 run, to a small sweet-gum a corner of Robert Darden, then south forty two
 degrees east forty poles to a large white oak, a corner of Etheldreda Gardner and
 Robert Darden; then north twenty four degrees east, eighty poles to a pine in Baker's line
 then north three degrees East twenty four and three fourths poles to a red oak at the fork
 of the road, from a straight line of marks runs to the fork at which continuing by a
 late survey two hundred and twenty nine acres every the same more or less together
 with all the necessary remains, rents, profits, services, and emoluments of the said
 land and premises, and every part or parcel thereof, To have and to hold the
 said land and premises, with the appurtenances unto the said Theophilus Daugtrey his
 heirs and assigns forever and the said Etheldreda Gardner and Lydia his wife for ever
 holding the said land and premises and every part or parcel thereof and
 against all and every other person or persons whatsoever to the said Theophilus
 Daugtrey his heirs or assigns for ever, and the said Etheldreda Gardner and
 Lydia his wife for themselves their heirs or shall devise, warrant and forever
 defend the said land and premises unto the said Theophilus Daugtrey his heirs or
 assigns forever from all manner of persons laying any claim thereto, In witness whereof
 the said Etheldreda Gardner and Lydia his wife to both put their hands and affixed
 their seals the day and year above written.
