 or assigns, have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed, conveyed and confirmed, and
 each of them do hereby, grant, bargain, sell, alien, convey, convey and confirm unto
 the said Drury Williams, all the right, title claim demand and interest of them and each
 of them in or to the said lands and appurtenances, before described and contained, and
 all houses buildings ways rights, easements, and hereditaments thereto belonging
 or in any ways appertaining with the premises and demands, services and services
 rents, profits and emoluments, To have and to hold all the property, right
 title, interest, claim and demand, that they and each of them now have or shall or may
 hereafter have or claim or, of or to the said lands and appurtenances unto the said
 Drury Williams and his heirs forever in fee simple and absolute fee simple
 unto the said John Williams, Silas Williams, Brunell Brunell and Fanny his wife
 (late Fanny Williams) Benjamin Williams, Jeremiah Williams Lucy Williams
