

Know all men by these presents that I Nathan Williams Trustee for Joseph Morris acting under the said trust which was made signed sealed & delivered bearing date the 19th day of October 1805, for certain uses and purposes therein contained for and in consideration of the sum of twenty two pounds four shillings and nine pence half penny paid by Lewis Morris as bargain & sale of said Lewis Morris acting by virtue of said trust and deliver to him the said Lewis Morris the following property to wit, two head of horses, four head of cattle two sheep twelve head of hogs one feather bed & furniture one feather bed & two potatoe cases knives & forks one iron pot & books one joggins pan one iron and gun two plow bay, one chain one safe, one wooden wheel store for him one pine chest, and all the remainder of his property that is not heretofore mentioned with all the future incomes arising from the above mentioned property which property with other profits as therein conveyed by said trust, I the said Nathan Williams do for myself my heirs & representatives give claim to the said property unto the said Lewis Morris his heirs and representatives forever for myself my heirs & representatives warrant the right & title of the said property the said Lewis Morris against the claim or demands of all persons whomsoever insofar as I Nathan Williams am authorized under the said trust and the further said writings whereof the said Nathan Williams have become set his hand this 21st day of August 1808

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This Indenture, made this 13th day of January in the year of our Lord 1807 between Joshua King of the County of Southampton and parish of St. Mary of the one part and Micah Ellis of the County and parish aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Joshua King for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and thirty one dollar current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Ellis - Micah Ellis before the writing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof the said Joshua King hath hereby acknowledged and thereof against and discharged the said Micah Ellis his heirs and assigns forever, be the said Joshua King hath granted bargain sold conveyed released delivered & conveyed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell convey release deliver
