This Indenture made this 18th day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred seven, between John Mues of the County of Southampton the one part and Samuel Corbett of the same County of the other parts, Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of forty two pounds nine shillings current money of England to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by him the said Samuel Corbett his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, all the estate right title and claim interest and demand in and to a certain tract or parcel of land forming the property of Allen Corbett, and which said tract or parcel of land was conveyed in part to William Mues for the security of a debt due to the said Mues, which said debt is hereby acknowledged to be paid and discharged, wherefore, be it known that I do for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, with hereby warrant & defend by the said bargain & promise, to him the said Samuel Corbett all my right, title and interest therein as aforesaid to him the said William Mues who has the same in trust as aforesaid in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this day & date above written -
