KNOW all men by these presents that I William Vaughan of Southampton county  
being indebted to Henry Barrow of the same County the just and full sum of Four hundred  
and Ninety dollars and fifty four Cents and being willing and desirous to secure the payment  
thereof have as well for the consideration of the aforesaid sum of Four hundred and Ninety  
dollars and fifty four cents as also the sum of One dollar to me in hand paid by him  
Harris as witness for the said Henry Barrow the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
I the said William Vaughan have granted bargain and sold and by these presents do  
grant bargain and sell unto the said Nail Harris the following tract of Land to  
wit. Beginning at a pine near Coxes Swamp a corner tree between William Butts and  
the said Vaughan thence along the said Butts line to John Barrows line thence  
along the said Barrows line to Coxes Swamp thence down the said Swamp to the  
beginning containing One hundred and twenty five acres Land more or less (the same  
tract of land willed to me by William Vaughan deceased) TO HAVE and to hold the  
the aforesaid property unto the said Nail Harris to the only proper use and behoof  
of the said Nail Harris his heirs or Executors in special trust and confidence  
to the intent and purpose that if the aforesaid sum of Four hundred and Ninety  
dollars and fifty four cents shall remain unpaid to the said Henry Barrow his heirs  
Exors admors or assigns at or upon the fifteenth day of June next that then the  
said Nail Harris his heirs Exors admors shall after giving reasonable notice  
upon the aforesaid property to public sale at any time after the first day of July  
next ensuing and with the money arising therefrom first to pay and satisfy the  
aforesaid sum of Four hundred and Ninety dollars and fifty four cents with interest  
and Cents as also the expenses attending the execution of this trust and the surplus  
if any to return to me the said William Vaughan my heirs Exors or admors. In

1809
