This Indenture made this 31st day of March in the year of our Lord Christ 1807 between Sarah Wick of the one part John Plaque Senr of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesses that whereas the said Sarah Wick stands justly indebted unto the said John Plaque Senr in the sum of one hundred and twenty five pounds current money of the State of Virginia as per his certain bond bearing equal date with these presents well more fully appear and of the said bond being for the sum of thirty five pounds and due twelve months from the date hereof (and the other being for twenty pounds due two years from this date, and whereas the said Sarah Wick for herself has been executed & sworn is residing and desirous of securing the payment thereof punctually when due, and the said John Plaque Senr has been executed & sworn to assign by conveying unto the said William Edwards his heirs executors or assigns in Trust, the following property to wit one certain negro girl called and known by the name of Rachelle about sixteen years old, and also one certain tract plantation and parcel of land and its appurtenances, being the same tract that the said Sarah Wick lately purchased of the said John Plaque Senr by his wife as by their certain Indenture of bargain and sale bearing even date with these presents well more fully appear, containing by the bonds thereby one hundred & twenty five pounds more or less, it and for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid and for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar, so here paid by the said William Edwards unto the said Sarah Wick before the signing sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Wick, hath granted bargained sold aliened conveyed & confirmed and by these presents with thirty five pounds well aliened conveyed unto the said William Edwards his heirs and assigns, the aforesaid negro girl Rachelle and her increase and also one certain tract plantation or parcel of land with appurtenances, to have and to
